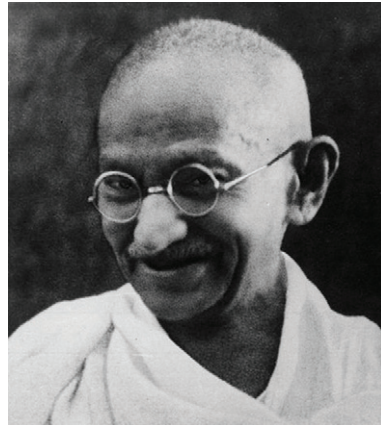


27 June: Celebrate **UNARMED** **FORCES DAY**

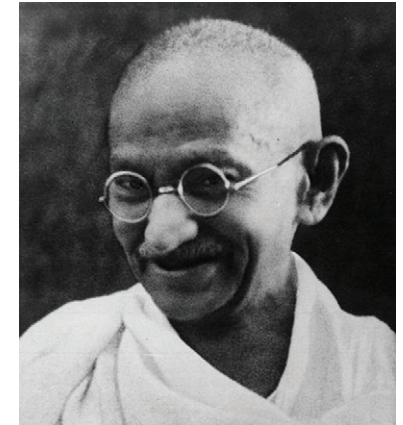
